- Ask questions if you have them; our Pastors, ushers, and the people sitting around you are great sources of information and are happy to help you feel comfortable here.



Shortly after Haslett Community Church was founded, a young choir member, new mother, and elementary music teacher in the Haslett School District accepted an assignment as the church's interim choir director. Judy Connelly's assignment ended 54 years later, in August, 2022.

The story begins with Judy's farming family in Dexter, MI. She attended school there until the seventh grade when she transferred to University High School on U of M's campus, aspiring to become a singer and a teacher. A Bachelor's degree from Albion College and a Masters from MSU followed.

In the meantime, her husband, Chuck, took an engineering position at what is now MDOT, and she started teaching elementary music students in Haslett's school system—becoming part-time as her own children arrived. She joined HCC as well, singing in the choir for 6 years, until, in her words "Things abruptly changed." HCC's music director took a position elsewhere, and Reverend Bob Frederick asked her to fill in for "two weeks". The rest, as they say, is history!

Judy's choirs were engaged and dedicated to the choir's work. She created and directed Children's and Youth choirs. She recruited guest musicians from the greater Lansing Area including MSU's College of Music. Judy led the choir on international tours, in England and in Germany, and she organized evening cabaret programs of lighter musical fare. Judy cared for every performer and every audience member, and that love was felt and returned in kind.

Here's what Judy says about it, "A wonderful 54 years has passed and it's time to sit back and enjoy the work of others. When I think back to what has occurred, especially the two trips to Europe, the various musical events we were part of, the assortment of music we performed and the love and caring of this special group of people through the years I will be eternally grateful. Thank you to all of you for your continued support."

We thank YOU Judy, for all of your years of loving dedication to making the music at HCC so wonderful for so many years!
