What do you love most about the Easter season? Is it the celebration of the resurrection of Christ and imagining what it must have been like to come upon the empty tomb?

And for that, we rejoice and give thanks!

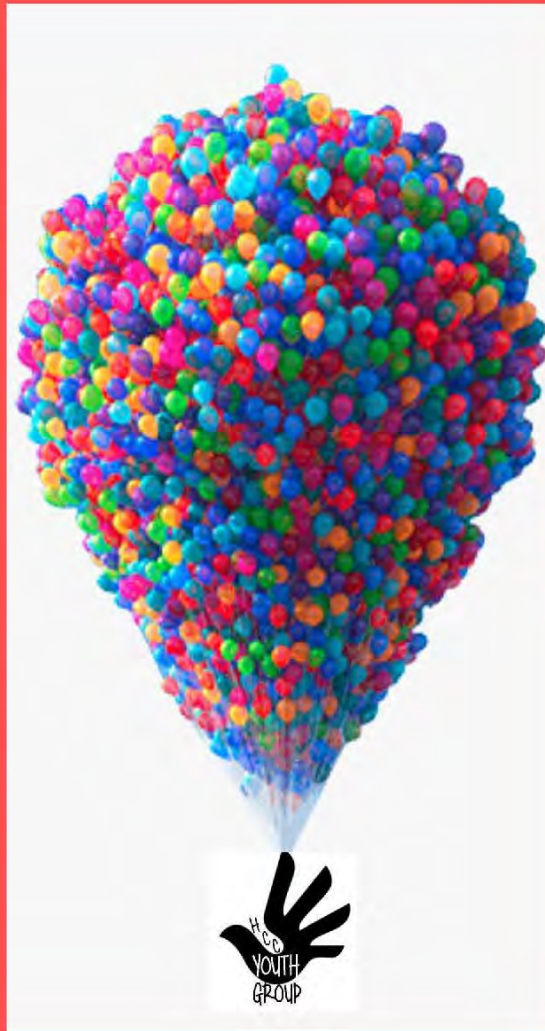

For our 2021 mission trip we are going UP! To the Upper Peninsula, that is...

We will be serving with God's Country Cooperative Parish (based in Newberry, Michigan, but serving in numerous communities in the region). Their mission is to connect and serve the churches and people of the parish. Service opportunities include: home repair, ramp construction, free lunch program for children, a free store for the community and other projects tailored to our group's interest and abilities.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Trip dates: June 19-26th
Cost: \$400 per person (scholarships are available in any amount, info is attached).

PAYMENTS DUE:

\$100 non-refundable deposit due by March 28th
\$150 due by April 25th
\$150 due by May 16th

Covid precautions and considerations:

Not all of our safety precaution specifics are set at this time. Currently, they include: sleeping areas that include beds, set 6 feet apart. We will also be requiring that all adult halferones (19-20 year olds) and chaperones (21 year olds and older) be vaccinated. There will also be specific times that masks are required over the course of the week. The specifics will be set and shared at the pre-trip parent and pre-trip youth meetings. Parents who have specific concerns/suggestions are encouraged to share them directly with Erin.

Summer is busy, so we do our best to accommodate those who need to join us late or leave us early. We ask that you do your best to be able to spend the majority of the work week (M-Th) with us. All accommodations must be worked out with Erin and additional travel cost(s) of such does not lower the HCC trip rate.

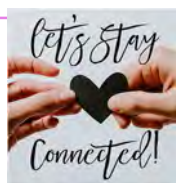
Patsy passed away after a long health battle following a stroke this past December. Please pray for comfort for her children, Pamela and James, and all who knew and cared for Patsy.

Community is vital to answering the call to learn how we can actively love others (particularly those different from us), love our opponents (not labeling those who oppose or even harm us as enemies), and how to truly love ourselves. This is not weak love, but requires courage to name hurts and injustices, be vulnerable in safe community with our grief and rage, and work together for healing of all as each of us is able.
