
Wherever you are led this summer, I pray the journey is a blessed one.

Next up is the parking lot. Over the course of Council, Property, and Finance meetings, the decision was made to resurface the entire parking lot, rather than just repair the south side entrance where the sewer project took place, especially since the entire lot is long past the point of some tar and sealant being helpful.

Flowers and Foundations will cover a portion of the cost, and the remainder coming from a low-interest loan/line of credit. We hope and expect the lot to be complete before returning in September, but do not yet have dates. We will keep you posted!


Women's Group
