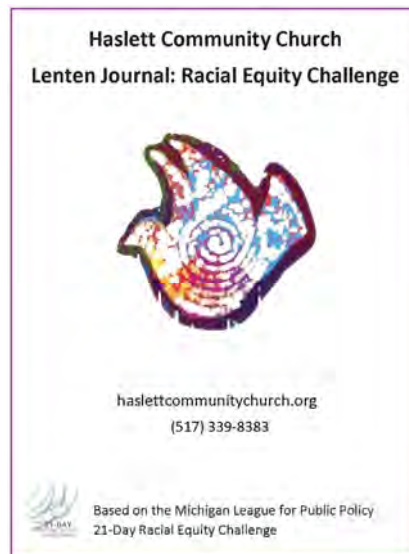

- **Saturday, April 3, 2021**

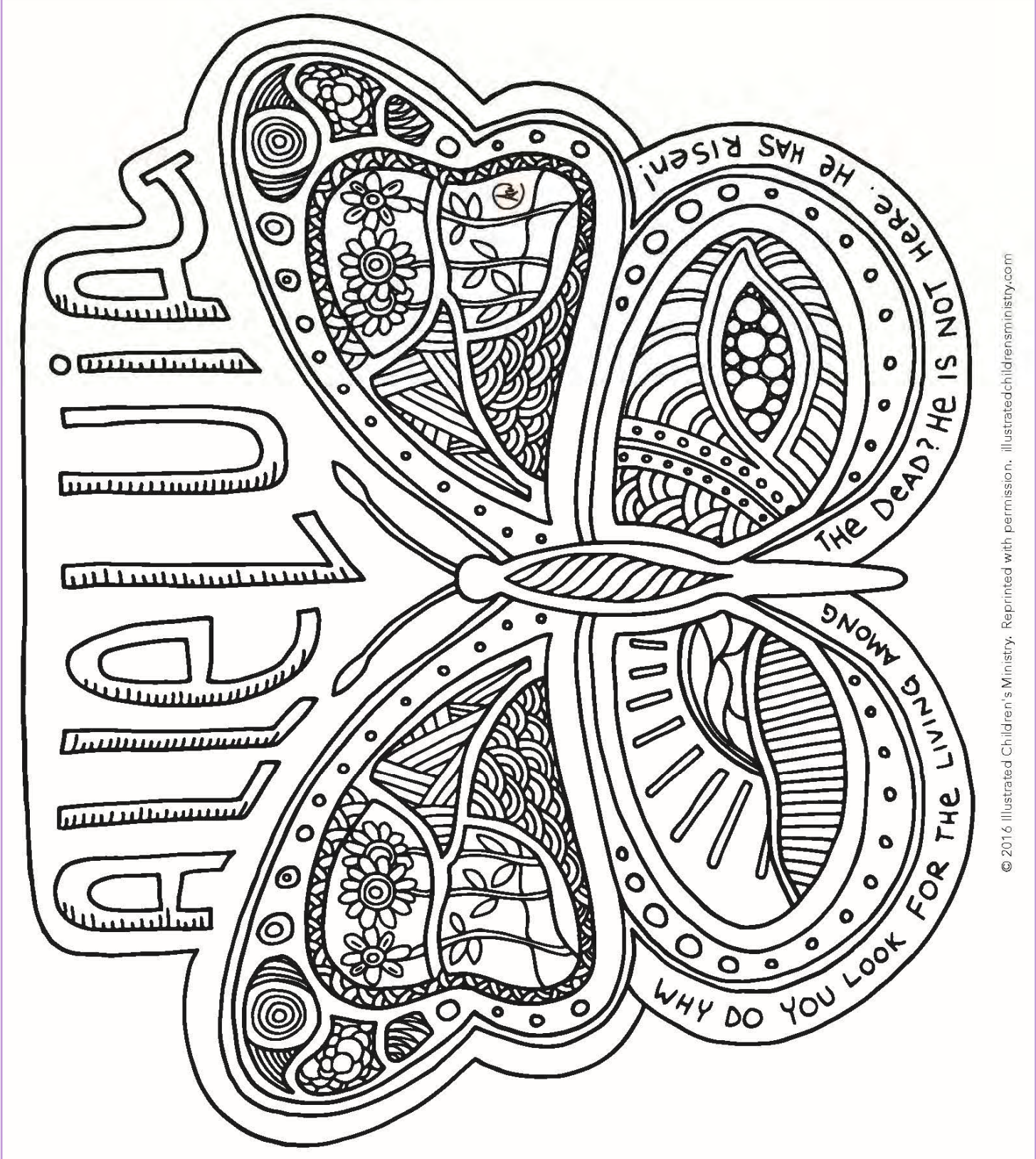
On those two days, for every \$10 donation card purchased, Meijer will provide an additional contribution of \$20, resulting in a total donation of \$30 to our food pantry.

COVID19 Vaccine News:

Michigan is currently in Phase 1b of vaccine prioritization. In addition to all healthcare, frontline, and essential workers from critical infrastructure, Phase 1b also includes ANYONE AGE 65 AND OVER.

Currently, the supply does not meet the demand, but if eligible, you are encouraged to register to be notified when there is an appointment available. This can take persistence. Much of the registration is being done online through your county's health department, or through Sparrow Hospital, but you can also call your doctor to inquire, or call your pharmacy. Meijer and Rite-Aid are accepting registrations for the public, and this can be done by phone or online.

Do not hesitate to be put on more than one list. If you get an appointment through one source, you simply turn down the appointments elsewhere when called. The vaccines available require 2 doses to be effective; once you get the first shot, you will be able to schedule your second one.

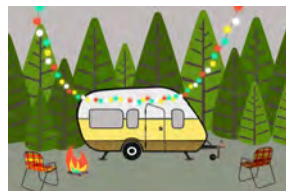

Coffee with Jesus continues in our exploration and applications of practices of Revolutionary Love, as laid out in Valarie Kaur's book, **See No Stranger, a Memoir of Revolutionary Love**. Each of you is also invited into learning more about Revolutionary Love, learning how we, as beloved community, can "birth a world where we see no stranger, a world anchored in the ethic of love."

Please join us in spirit, if not in person, by checking out www.valariekaur.com. There you will find many resources to explore, and perhaps, in the Learning Hub of the site, to engage with the explanations and core practices Valarie sets out in her book. Or perhaps you might order the book through your favorite site. It is also available as an e-book on platforms such as Kindle and Audible.

Valarie says, "Love calls us to look upon anyone and say: You are a part of me I do not yet know. Love calls us to be brave with our grief and take in those wounded, neglected, and abused as our own flesh and blood. Revolutionary love calls us to harness our rage in the face of injustice."

Community is vital to answering the call to learn about how we can actively love others (particularly those different from us), love our opponents (not labeling those who oppose or even harm us as enemies, a term that leads to demonizing or completely shutting them out), and how to truly love ourselves. This is not weak love, but requires courage to name hurts and injustices, be vulnerable in safe community with our grief and rage, and work together for healing of all as each of us is able.
