"When they had heard the king, they set out, and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen in the east, until it stopped over the place where the child was." - Matthew 2:9

The season of Epiphany is a season of traveling in trust, and of Christ being revealed. We will celebrate the start of Epiphany on Sunday, January 7, and the season lasts until Lent starts.

The part that is harder for me, is the traveling in trust part. I am here for Christ's fullness of divinity and humanity being revealed. Even if I can't completely comprehend it, even though there are not words to adequately describe it.

But traveling in trust? That can be hard.

Every moment, every day, every week, month and yes, every New Year, presents new unknowns. And we are expected to just ... keep moving forward and traveling in trust.

Sounds kind of scary. Or exciting. Depending on what your path is like at the moment.

When the Magi set out from the East to find Jesus, they had nothing but a star to guide them. They had no maps nor promise of safety. Just a sense that it was important for them to make the journey. To travel to the Messiah, to see him for themselves and to honor him.

If you feel like whatever path you are on requires a little more trust and a little less assurance than what you are used to or what you would prefer, know that you are not alone. There are so many putting one foot in front of the other, and praying that when their foot lands there will be something firm to step on.

The Magi had to just put one foot in front of the other, too ... relying on the light of a star that would lead them to the Messiah. Wherever your next step takes you, may you find solace in the light of a star leading you closer to Jesus.

So, please stay tuned for more information to be provided in this new month of 2024.


