The Fifth of and Into S Dear Haste

The Fifth Gospel: Isaiah Steps Out of Advent and Into Summer

Dear Haslett Community Church,

Summer is a great time to explore the world in a new way. What are your favorite ways to explore in the summer: Looking up at the stars? Going to

the HCC Summer Concert Series (see pg 2)? Spending time on or near water? Camping with your HCC friends (see pg 6)? Seeing birds (and squirrels) at the birdfeeders? A night at the ballpark? Welcoming new plants to your garden? Worshiping outdoors (see pg 7)? All great summer pursuits!

July is also a great time to explore scripture together in a new way. I love the Lectionary (the schedule of Bible readings that we use in worship from September through Pentecost) because it challenges the preacher to use passages they may not choose, it is set up in a way that makes sense, there are resources for study and worship readily available for preaching and worship planning, and honestly if the Lectionary dictates the passages it is just one less decision to make!

But in summer we get to choose some different themes or reading schedules, and that can be interesting and challenging, too!

In June, we focused on our United Church of Christ identity, in preparation for Erin and I to participate in General Synod, the biennial national gathering of our denomination. Synod takes place this year in Indianapolis from June 30-July 4, but we will return on July 2. We can't wait to tell you about our experiences and learnings when we return!

Beginning on July 9, we spend four weeks studying themes of the prolific prophet Isaiah. The Old Testament book of Isaiah has been called "the Fifth Gospel" because it contains themes

of brokenness and judgement, but also restoration, healing, redemption, and community. We only get a couple of weeks with Isaiah in the Lectionary each year, and often around Christmas. By spending time in Isaiah during the summer, we will hear the Prophet with new ears. Each Isaiah passage will be paired with a Gospel passage, too, so we recognize the echoes of the prophet in the life of Christ.

I hope, however elaborate or simple your summer plans, you explore the world in a new way, even from a window. And, I hope you join us in exploring scripture, too! We are designed to be in community, and I'm so glad you are part of Haslett Community Church, United Church of Christ.



ership they provided in pulling the event together.


