Dear Haslett Community Church,

Because my household is tied to the school calendar, with both 1) a spouse who is a teacher and 2) a son in high school, I often convince myself that the end of the school year means that life will generally be less busy. But, "less busy" isn't really how I would describe summer. It isn't really less busy... it is just less structured. Still a lot to do, learn, explore, and participate in. Just with less regularity, rhythm, or predictability. Chaos or freedom? It's a fine line.

The same is true of our church. The summer is full of opportunities to learn, share, have fun, worship, grow, and explore, but it isn't quite as routine as the rest of the year. You will see that throughout this edition of HCC Connections, so please take some time to read through it, and see what catches your eye! There are new and different opportunities all around us. From the Summer Concert Series to Art Film conversations to the Mission Trip, to All-Church Camping to Outdoor Worship, to Vacation Bible School and more, I hope you find something that feeds your spirit and invites your sense of wonder.

We go a bit off the beaten path in worship, too. The Narrative Lectionary (a four-year cycle of scheduled scripture readings for each Sunday) begins with Genesis/Creation Stories in September and ends with Pentecost in late spring (May 28 this year). Which gives us creative freedom in the summer. At the end of the month, Erin and I are traveling to Indianapolis for a portion of General Synod, the national gathering of the United Church of Christ that takes place biennially (every 2 years). Leading up to the event, our preaching series will focus on various aspects of the United Church of Christ (UCC). We will incorporate scripture, song, and creative elements as we learn about our denomination's mission, vision, history, trajectory, beliefs, and more. For some, the UCC may be an important part of why HCC is your church, for others, it may not be. There is no right or wrong way to be, but we can still all learn together, and I hope you will be part of it. May summer, the sometimes-chaotic summer, also bring a sense of Holy wonder!!

**Introducing: Landon Black, Choral Conductor Intern**

We are thrilled to welcome Landon Black into the HCC community, where, beginning this fall, he will be our first Choral Conductor Intern! This new position comes from a restructuring of HCC's Music Ministry since Judy Connelly's retirement in August 2022. Barbara Freeman will remain in the role of Church Musician, and Landon will conduct the HCC Choir for most rehearsals and worship services throughout the school year. You may have noticed Landon as our Guest Conductor for two of the Anthems during worship for Judy's Joyous Jubilee on May 21, and we are so glad that this highly recommended and talented musician will return in September in an environment of teaching, learning, and mutual support with Haslett Community Church. Barbara and the HCC Choir are already singing his praises!

Landon Black is a third year Vocal Performance and Music Education double major at Michigan State University. He loves to sing but also has experience playing many different instruments, including drums, piano, bass guitar, and acoustic guitar. Performance experience includes singing at events such as commencement ceremonies, singing the national anthem for various sporting events, and participating in MSU Opera theater in shows like; Falstaff, L'enfant et les sortilèges, and La finta giardiniera. Some teaching experience includes teaching pieces for the MSU Men's glee (now

known as Spartan Glee), and mini lessons with some high schools in the greater Lansing area. When he graduates from MSU, Landon's goal is to become a high school choir director to teach the next generation of music educators.





If you have ever been curious about teaching Sunday school or volunteering in the nursery, summer is a great time to try it out for one Sunday!

### NEW and Improved Confirmation

Last summer we kicked off a new confirmation process. No longer an official class confirmands have to attend, the new model is much more individualized. Students are paired with a mentor from the congregation. Together, they'll read one of the gospels. They'll also work together to get to know HCC, the UCC, and what church involvement looks like. With their families, confirmands will explore questions of our faith through watching short videos and thinking through questions.

Students are invited to embark on their journey whenever they feel ready. A family, for example, might find it easiest to have more than one student go through this at the same time (so they're all learning together). And there is no set timeline for how soon they must complete all the tasks. Some students may get through it in a few months, while others might take over a year.

The hope is that students will find this new program accessible and easy to incorporate into their lives- which hopefully will then carryover into finding time and space for church, faith, etc to be a continued part of their life following confirmation.

To begin, families just need to talk to Erin. A two-week heads up is appreciated to get supplies prepped and a mentor secured.

## An Evening of Art Films & Conversation with Erik Ferguson

Sunday, June 11, 6:00 p.m. on Zoom

Together we will watch two short art films and engage in conversation with one of the directors, performers, and founders of Wobbly Dance!

Erik Ferguson and Yulia Arakelyan formed [Wobbly Dance](#) more than 15 years ago as an interrogation on the meaning of dance, and performance in the context of the disabled body, being human and seeking spirit in its many forms. Characterized by lush, immersive, and fantastical natural environments, their work, both live and in film is challenging, beautiful and full of questions.

Their first film, *Waking the Green Sound*, a Dance Film for the Trees features Wobbly Dance with guest artist Grant Miller. A wordless fable of sorts, the film follows three characters across three landscapes through extremes of anguish, joy, and curiosity, painting a nameless myth about some visceral quest for meaning that is felt more than spoken.



Their second film, *Tidal*, explores a story book ocean scene this time, two partners don their CPAP masks like scuba divers falling backward into a dream of water, breath, mystery, and of course, Love.

### What's Happening at HCC in April
