"Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome got out as fast as they could, beside themselves, their heads swimming. Stunned, they said nothing to anyone." - Mark 16:8, The original ending to Mark's Gospel

The original ending to the Gospel of Mark is my favorite.

But it shouldn't be.

It is certainly not an ending that ... um ... ends? It stands alone in that.

Matthew's Gospel ends with the disciples encountering the resurrected Jesus and being given the Great Commission ("Go and make disciples of all nations…"), John's Gospel tells of many encounters and conversations between the resurrected Christ and various disciples, including not just Mary Magdalene but also "Doubting Thomas," Peter, and more. And the writer of Luke's Gospel tells of the Ascension of Jesus and then kept on writing, as the Book of Acts is the same author, a continuation of Luke.

All the other Gospels have more to say about what happens after the tomb is found empty, and are certainly tidier and more respectable endings than Mark is, where they just went away and didn't say anything (at least not right away?).

But the original ending of Mark's Gospel is still my favorite. In fact, it is such an abrupt end that as time went on, more complete endings were added. And, of course there is debate as to whether those later editions should be included or not, so the compromise is that our Bibles show the "shorter" and "longer" added endings in brackets after the original, uncomfortable, unfinished ending.

But, I'll stick with the original ending, thank you very much. Why?

Because it is an invitation, a mystery and a choose-your-own-adventure all rolled into one. It is messy and unpredictable and leaves me with all sorts of questions and hope and wonder and anticipation. Just like life. Just like a life of faith. By the time we get to the part where the women leave the empty tomb stunned and silent, we are cheering for them to say something, to celebrate the miracle, to tell others about the goodness of what they have experienced after so much pain of the days leading up to discovering the tomb empty.

Are we willing to walk through the darkest moments of Jesus' last days during Holy Week? And what will we choose what we do with the glorious mystery of the resurrection? You are invited into all of it, exactly as you are.




