Dear youth families,

Mission trips are a long-standing tradition at Haslett Community Church. This summer we will take our 27<sup>th</sup> youth mission trip. From the outset, our Youth Ministry Team was aware that need exists all over our world, but they felt that it was important to show our youth the need that exists right here in the United States; so while opportunities exist to serve all over, we have been committed to staying in the US. This year's seniors debated all of the mission trip options carefully and ultimately chose this particular trip because of the wide array of the types of service projects this trip will involve.

This year we will be traveling to Nashville, Tennessee the week of June 17-24, 2023! We will be partnering again with Service Learning Camps, a Minneapolis based organization that seeks to provide youth with opportunities to both serve communities while also learning about issues relating to their service sites. I want parents to know that I do **not** take the responsibility of traveling with your children lightly; **safety** is always my first priority (both in choosing the group we work with as well as planning every single detail of the trip). I have led 19 of HCC's trips (and have attended 24 of the previous 26 trips)! In addition to myself, every year we are blessed to have an amazing team of chaperones that help with the leadership of these trips. If you have any questions about this trip at any point of the planning process, please be in touch!

From the beginning, our Youth Ministry Team (YMT) sought to keep mission trips affordable for families. We are proud that for over 20 years our trip participant fee was able to remain the same. This year, however, due to the increased rental, gas and food prices, we do need to slightly increase the participant fee to \$500/person. The experiences that mission trips offer are invaluable and for that reason, the YMT & I would hate for anyone to miss out on this experience for financial reasons. I want to stress that we have scholarships available for all youth, to help cover any portion of the cost! Please do not hesitate to speak with me if this is something that would ease the burden of the cost for your family! Scholarship information is 100% confidential- only I (Erin) know who receives them, so PLEASE don't hesitate to talk to me if this would be beneficial to your family! Also, for families with more than one family member going (whether student or adult), we offer a reduced rate for each additional family member (\$400/person), but again, scholarships are also available for ANYONE!

All of that being said, these trips are expensive endeavors. As our group has grown, so has the <u>necessity for our fundraising!</u> The "tuition" paid by each family, only covers part of the overall cost of the trip. For example, we pay Service Learning Camps a per person fee for the trip. In addition to that cost, we also have to cover all transportation costs (van rentals, gas, parking, etc), all of our food costs, as well as activities that we will do during our week, etc. Our fundraisers are what help to supplement these costs; which is why we stress the <u>importance of each family's commitment to helping with our fundraisers</u>. We are expecting higher than usual travel costs (both at the gas pump, but also the cost for rental vehicles has skyrocketed compared to past trips).

We strive joyfully and prayerfully to warmly welcome all, freely share our blessings, and humbly explore God's love.

Attached you will find a **letter of commitment**- showing your commitment to the trip, to helping with fundraising and to **being involved in youth group** this year! I ask that the **youth AND a parent/guardian sign** the letter & return it with your \$100 nonrefundable deposit (per person) by December 4th.

The attached letter of commitment AND DEPOSIT will serve as the "contract"-reserving your spot on the list.

The payment schedule is:

**December 4th: \$100 deposit/person (nonrefundable)** 

January 29th: \$200 March 5th: \$200

Also, if you're **interested in being one of our adult chaperones**, please indicate that on your student's letter of commitment! It is an incredible experience. My own parents have gone on many trips with HCC and my dad says often, "I wish you would have made me do this sooner!"

While you're marking your calendar, please make note of one more important date. Sunday, June 25th will be Mission Trip Sunday. The day after we return from Nashville, the youth and chaperones come together to lead our Sunday morning service at HCC (10am). It is always a very moving service as they share stories about what they did, the impact the trip had on them and how they were transformed. I invite all of our youth families to be in worship that morning!
